## PAPER EDITING GUIDELINES

*The paper is to be drafted* in Romanian or an international language, in A4 format, a maximum of 8 pages, 20 mm left/right margins, 20 mm top/bottom margins (except the first page comprising the paper title, author, abstract and keywords), edited in Word, Times New Roman, size 12, 1 line spacing.

*The paper title* shall be 3 lines away from the bottom margin, center-page, in bold, size 14 block capitals.

*The authors' names and surnames* shall be 2 lines below the paper title, center-page, in bold, size 12 block capitals. Should there be several authors, write their names in a sequence.

*The authors' workplace* shall be listed center-page on the following line below the line containing the authors, in size 12 Aldines (bold).

*The abstract* (in English) shall be 2 lines below the line detailing the authors' workplace, size 12, and shall comprise a maximum of 10 lines.

*Keywords* are listed in size 12, 2 lines below the abstract.

*The paper text* shall start 2 lines below the keywords, in size 12 font.

*The chapter titles* shall be in left-aligned, bold block capitals, Times New Roman 12, and shall be numbered in Arabic figures.

*Paragraphs* making up the paper shall have a 15 mm indentation, justify alignment.

*Subparagraphs* shall have a 15 mm indentation, size 12 font, in bold.

*Sub-subparagraphs* shall be in center-page, Italic, size 12 font.

*Graphics* shall be in line with the text and numbered underneath.

*Formulas and equations* inserted in the text shall be numbered on the right side of the page.

*Tables* shall be in line with the text, numbered, and the title shall be placed on their left top side.

*The bibliography* shall be listed 2 lines below the end of the paper.
